Clay & gravel (Néac) and deep gravels
(Lalande-de-Pomerol)

Tillage of the soil and grass cover every
other row

49 HI/Ha

Fermentations in temperature-controlled
stainless steel vats

Aging partly in oak barrels in order to keep the
typicity and the authenticity of the terroir

Certified HVE 3 since the 2018 vintage



Intense red color. Nose of black fruits with
hints of spices. Frank attack, a fresh palate
with volume. This 2019 vintage is pretty
rich and will reach its peak in a couple of
years.
